We were forced to find alternative care when we found our currently caregiver was pregnant. It was our hope that we would find a location that would help our daughter with the skill set she would require for her upcoming JK experience. Unfortunately our Daughter was born later in the year and it was important that the care we put in place would focus much attention on learning and social skills.

After being provided a referral by a friend to Chestnut we met with Stacey to take a tour of the location. Both my husband and myself were impressed with location and what it had to offer. The kids were very well behaved when we arrived and it was nice to see a place with safety and structure in mind. We also appreciated that the location offered health lunches for the children. On many occasions they had to make special food arrangements for our Daughter as she wouldn't eat some of the normal things kids would eat. On one occasion Bonnie, ask us what she liked to eat, so she could tailor the meal plan to what she would eat. I was impressed that they took the time to care that one child required special treatment.

Over the course of our daughters stay with Chestnut Tree Preschool it was very apparent that her skill set was improving and she was on her way to being ready for school.

When I was asked to write a reference letter, I was thrilled to give back to the school that neutered and cared for our daughter.

I am happy to report that our daughter was more than ready when she attended JK last year and I attribute much of her success to the Chestnut program.
